



## **Parks Victoria December 2022 Board Meeting Report**

The Parks Victoria Board met on Tuesday 13 December 2022 and examined a number of priority issues and opportunities, with meeting highlights outlined below.

### **Nature Conservation Programs Quarterly Report**

The Board commended the progress of 83 active nature conservation projects at a total combined budget of \$22.9 million.

### **Health Safety and Environment Report**

The Board noted the end-November 2022 Total Recordable Injury Frequency Rate (TRIFR) trending up to 14.3 above the 12.5 target and endorsed the priority management actions underway to address.

### **Flood and Recovery programs**

The Board discussed with management the multiple recovery projects in place since 2019-20 that are allocated across five major streams, focusing on organisational capacity and resources, and prioritising staff wellbeing and fatigue management.

### **Fundraising Strategy 2022-25**

The Board approved implementation of the Parks Victoria Fundraising Strategic Plan 2022-2025 and nominated priorities for upcoming project announcements.

### **Expansion of Joint Management with Gunaikurnai**

The Board acknowledged the expansion of joint management with the Gunaikurnai Traditional Owner group with four parks and ten reserves handed back to the Gunaikurnai under the Recognition and Settlement Agreement (RSA) between the Gunaikurnai and the State.
