

## **FIRE PREPAREDNESS WORKS NOTIFICATION**

**Hazardous tree removal will take place in Dandenong Ranges National Park along Mountain View Road, Kalorama in preparation for planned burning**

**Date:** Early February 2023

**Duration:** Approximately 2 weeks (weekdays only)

**Location:** Mountain View Road and Childs Road, Kalorama (see map)

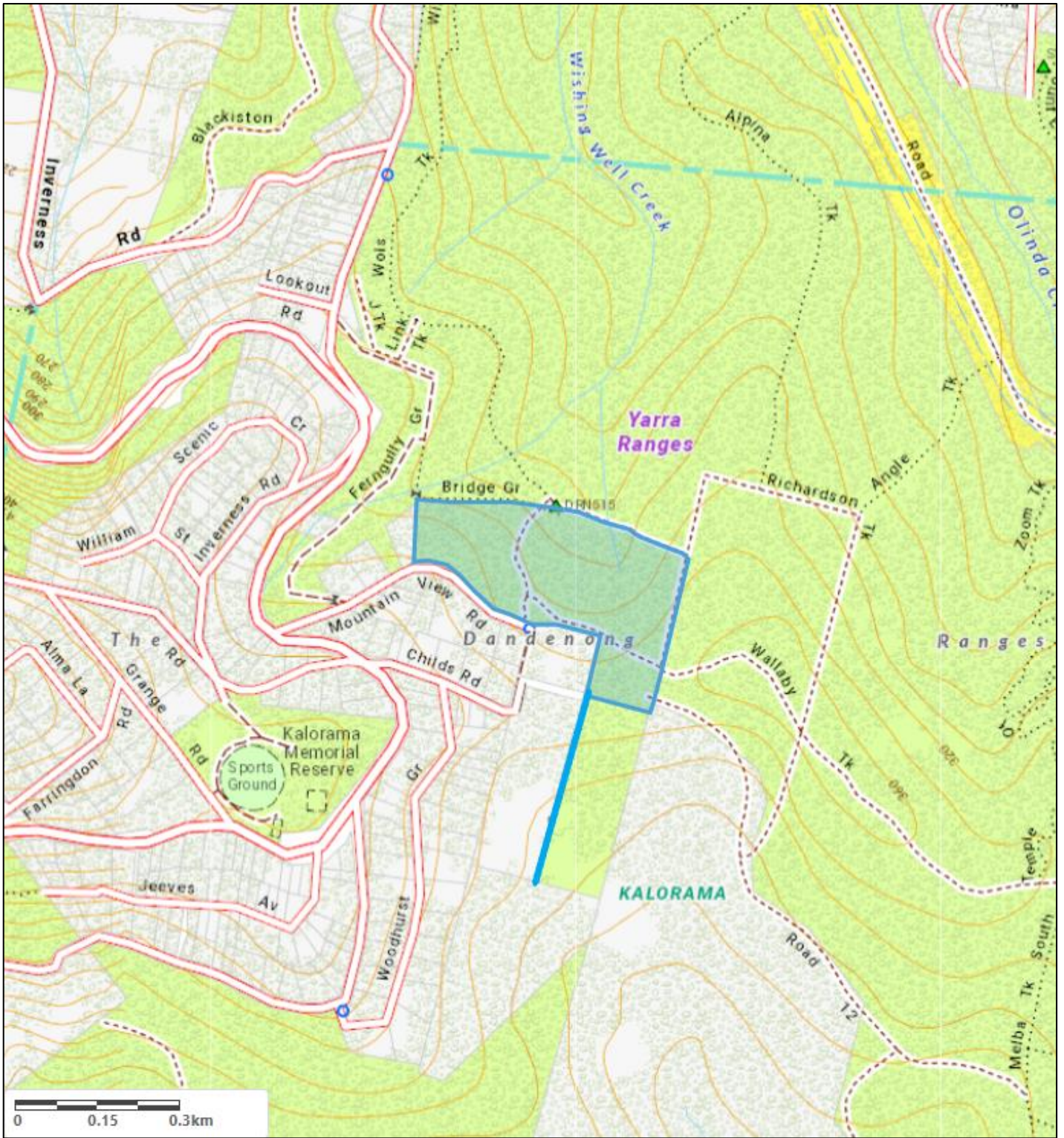
**Impact:** **Work crews and heavy machinery will be working in this area. There may be restricted access to parts of Wallaby track and Bridge Grove during the works.** You should avoid this area if possible, but if you must use the track, follow the instructions of the crew working on site.

Environmental and cultural heritage assessments have been undertaken to ensure important areas are protected.

**Why:** This area is within a bushfire Asset Protection Zone (APZ) and is managed regularly to reduce bushfire risk to the surrounding communities.

This work supports a planned burn scheduled for autumn 2023, if conditions are suitable. The removal of hazardous trees is critical for firefighter safety during these burns.
