



FIRE PREPAREDNESS WORKS NOTIFICATION

Hazardous tree removal will take place in Dandenong Ranges National Park near Mount Dandenong in preparation for planned burning

Date: October 2022

Duration: Approximately 2 weeks (weekdays only)

Location: Between Dacite Track and Camelia Track (see map)

Impact: **Work crews and heavy machinery will be working in this area.** There will be restricted access to Rankin Track, Camelia Track, Scar Track and Dacite Track during works. Park users may experience some delays. You should avoid this area, if possible.

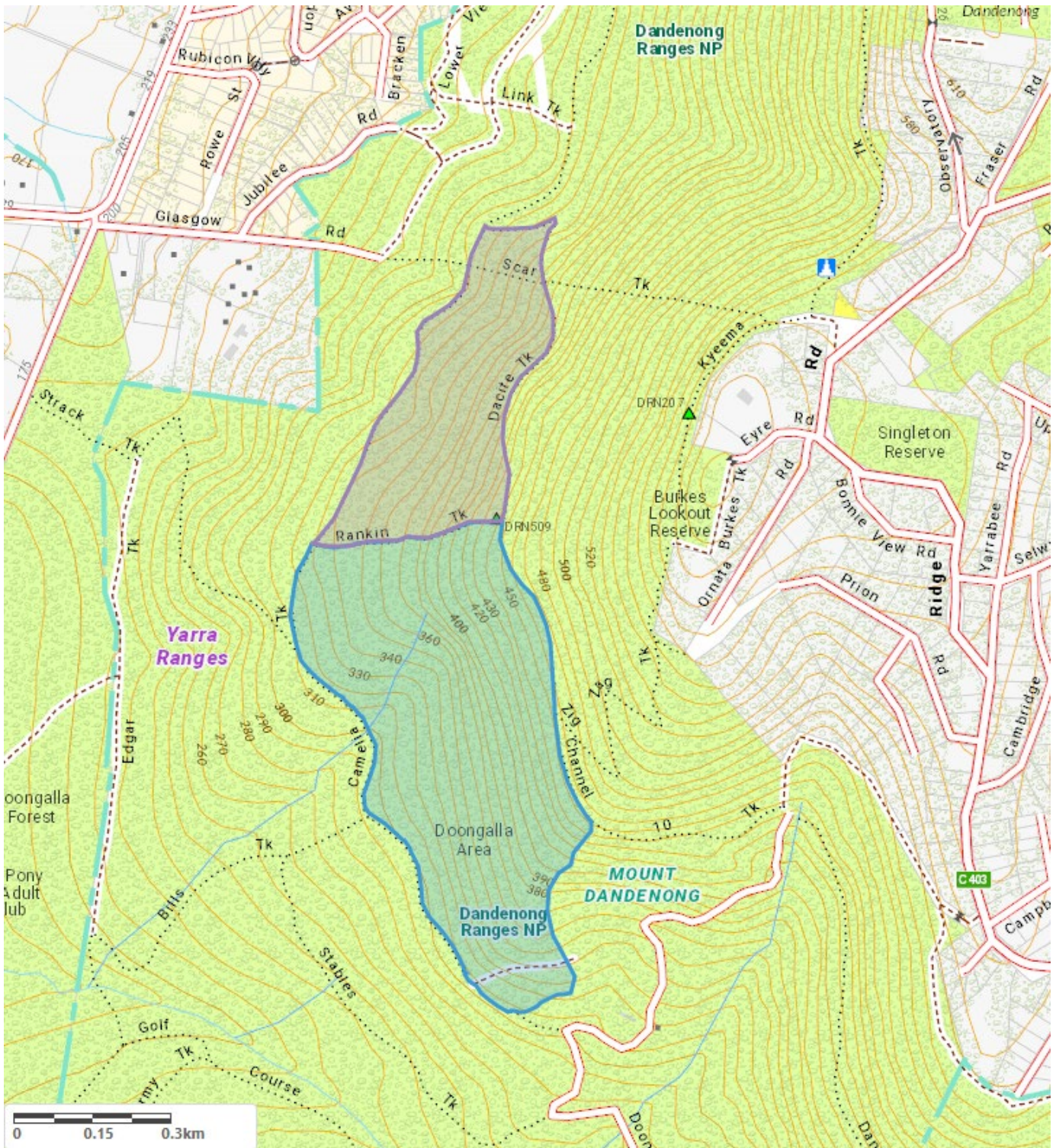
Environmental and cultural heritage assessments have been undertaken to ensure important areas are protected.

Why: This area is within a Bushfire Moderation Zone (BMZ) and is managed using planned burning and mechanical means to reduce bushfire risk to the surrounding communities.

This work supports the upcoming Dacite Track planned burn. The removal of hazardous trees is critical for firefighter safety during these burns.
