

FIRE PREPAREDNESS WORKS NOTIFICATION

Fuel break resurfacing works will take place in Dandenong Ranges National Park near Tecoma and Sherbrooke Falls to improve fire and emergency access

Date: September 2022

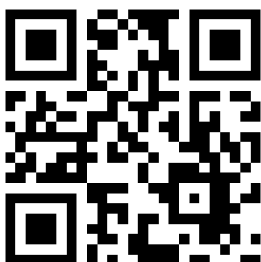
Duration: Approximately 1 week (weekdays only)

Location: Near Terrys Avenue and Pound Creek car park, near Tecoma and Sherbrooke Falls (see map)

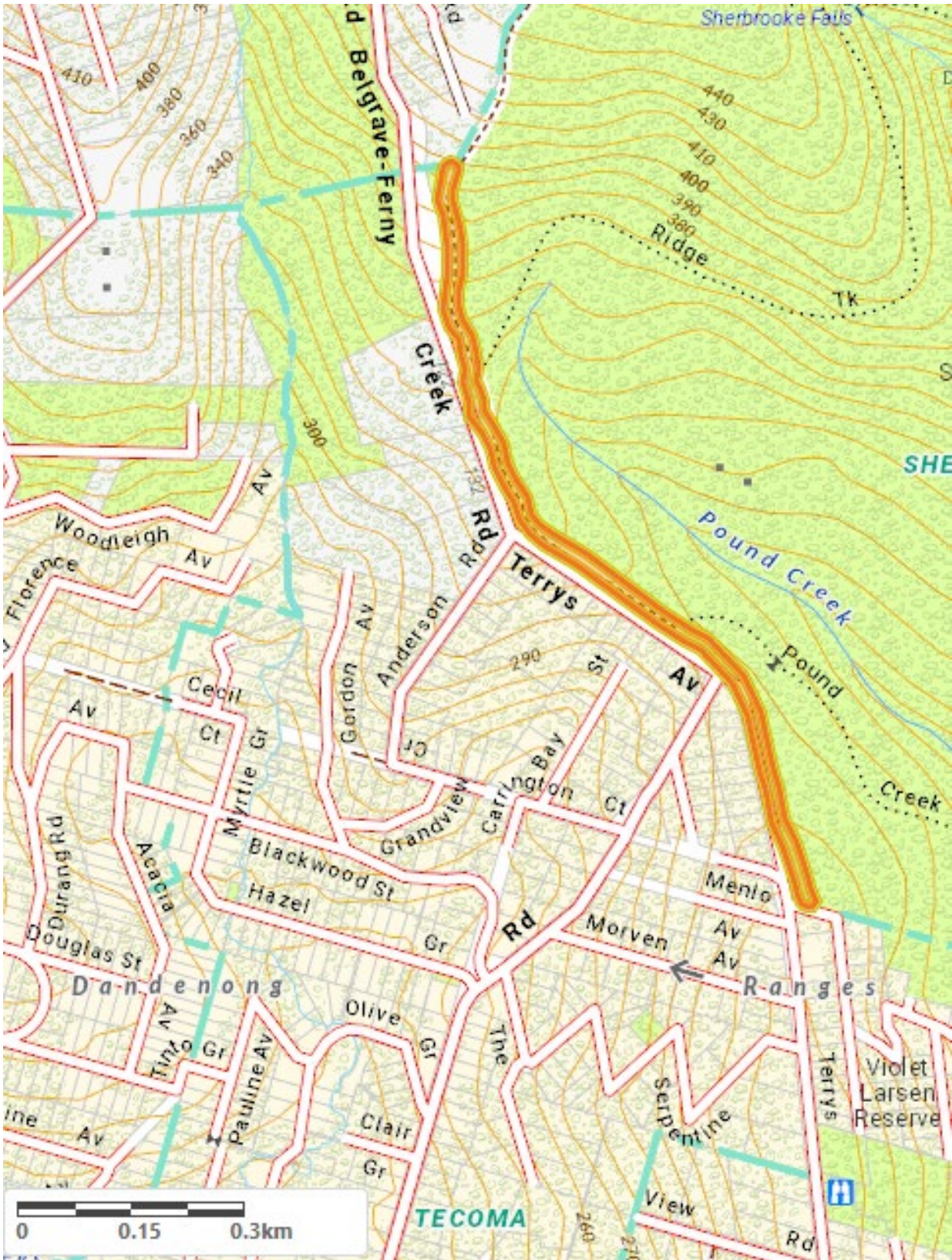
Impact: **Work crews and heavy machinery will be working in this area.** There will be restricted access to the track during works, park users may experience some delays. You should avoid this area if possible, but if you must use the track, follow the instructions of the crew working on site.

Environmental and cultural heritage assessments have been undertaken to ensure important areas are protected.

Why: These works are to repair storm damage to the fuel break and to improve access for both firefighting and our annual fuel break grass slashing program.
