

FIRE PREPAREDNESS WORKS NOTIFICATION

Drainage improvement and roading works will take place in Warrandyte State Park near Jumping Creek Reserve to improve fire and emergency access.

Date: Late November 2022

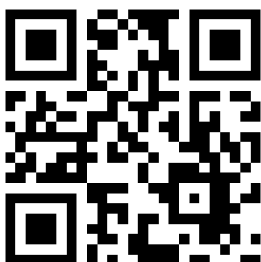
Duration: Approximately 2 weeks (weekdays only)

Location: Blue Tongue Bend Track, North Warrandyte (see map)

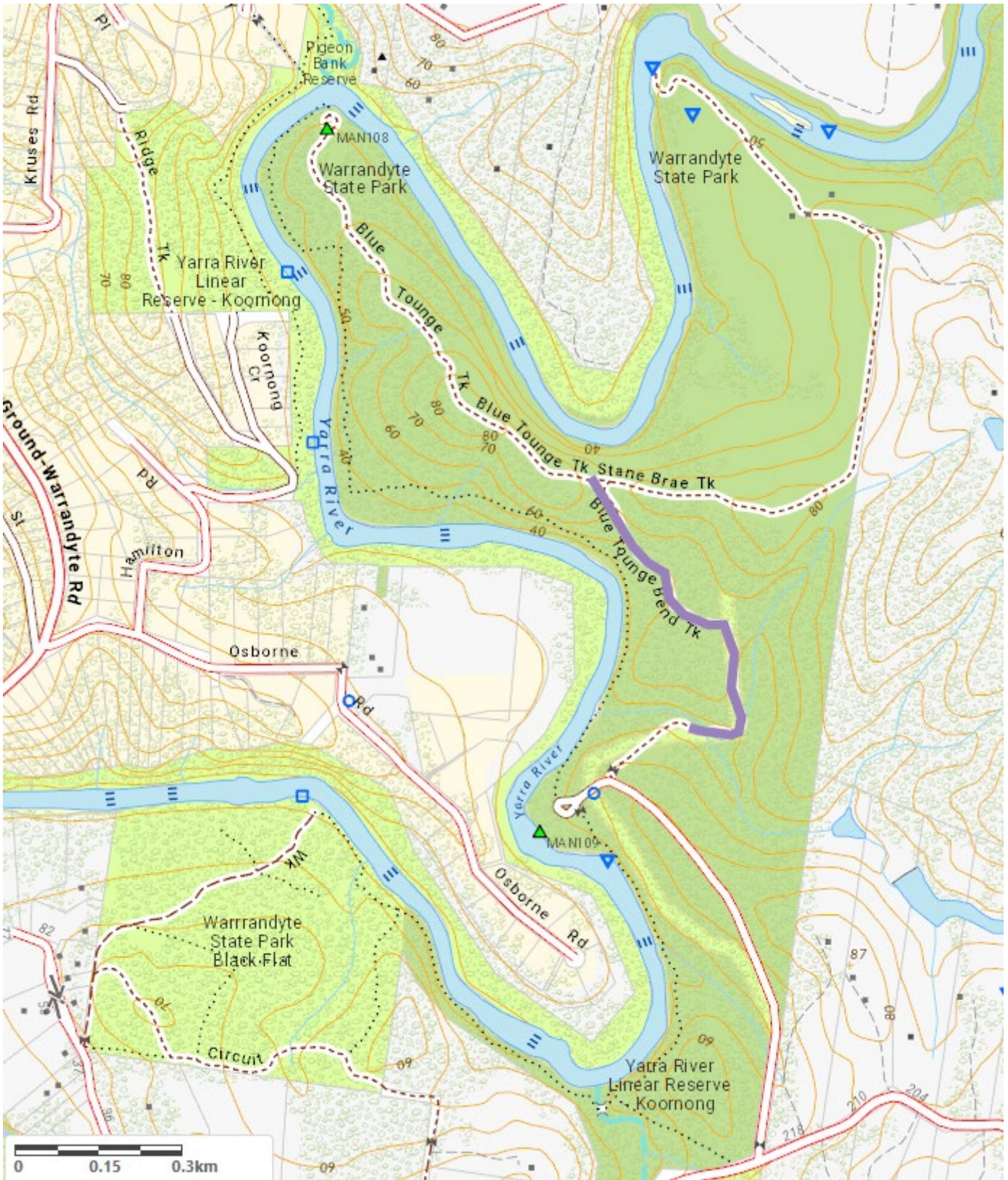
Impact: **Work crews and heavy machinery will be working in this area. There will be restricted access to Blue Tongue Bend track during works, park users may experience some delays.** You should avoid this area if possible, but if you must use the track, follow the instructions of the crew working on site.

Environmental and cultural heritage assessments have been undertaken to ensure important areas are protected.

Why: These works are maintaining drainage and road surface conditions to ensure fuel break access and safety for firefighting, planned burning and our annual fuel break grass slashing program.
