

FIRE PREPAREDNESS WORKS NOTIFICATION

**Selective hazardous tree treatment and vegetation mulching
will take place in Kinglake National Park on Running Creek
Track to reduce bushfire risk**

Date: Mid to late April 2023

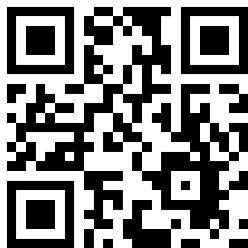
Duration: Approximately 4 weeks (weekdays only)

Location: Running Creek Track (see map)

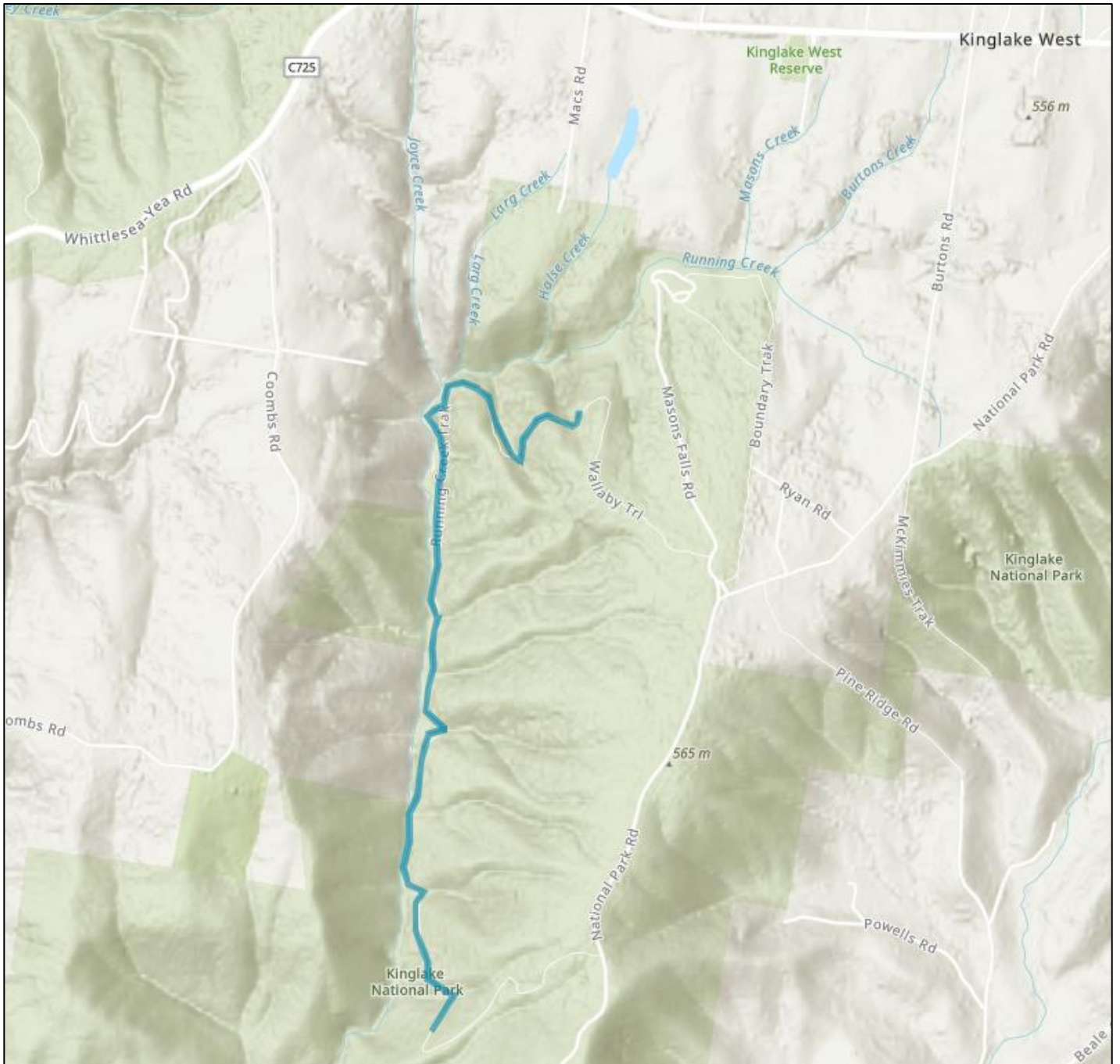
Impact: **Running Creek Track will be closed during works, avoid this area if possible.** Park users may experience some delays on Wallaby Trail due to work crews and heavy machinery in the area, however it will remain open. Follow any instructions from crews or signage when moving through the area.

Environmental and cultural heritage assessments have been undertaken to ensure important areas are protected.

Why: This area sits within a Bushfire Moderation Zone. These works are to improve the fuel break to facilitate access and safety for firefighting and planned burning.
