The following Notice to Mariners is published for general information.

Half Moon Bay - BOWS Swim Event

Date: Sunday 9 January 2022, between 0700hrs and 1100hrs

Details: Mariners are advised of a swim event in the vicinity of Half Moon Bay, during the times nominated above.
A set aside will exist around the competition area, which is bounded by the shore and the following approximate locations (WGS84):

1. 37° 58.145'S, 145° 0.630'E
2. 37° 57.500'S, 145° 0.320'E

The competition area will be delineated by marker buoys and patrolled by event marshals.

Relevant Law: The set aside has been established under Regulation 11(1)(2) of the *Port Management (Local Ports) Regulations 2015*. Entry is prohibited to all persons excluding the event participants and Parks Victoria officers.

Mariners are prohibited from entering the set aside area during the date and times nominated above and are advised to navigate with caution within the vicinity of the event.
